





GENERAL INFORMATION

The Military Selective Service Act requires you to have this STATUS CARD (SSS FORM 7) in your personal prospection until your liability for training and service is terminated or until you turn it in upon entering active duty in the Armed Forces.

You are required to keep your local board currently informed of your maling address and facts concerning your status that the local board requests. If you are in a deferred class, you are required to inform your local board (any change in your status which would affect your classification.

Any person who alters, forges, knowingly destroys, knowingly mutilates to any manner changes this card or who, for the purpose of false identification or representation has in his possession a certificate of another or who delivers his card to another to be used for such purpose, may be fined not to exceed \$10,000 or imprisoned for not more than 5 years, or both.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PERSONAL APPEARANCE AND APPEAL

Within 15 days after the date of mailing shown on this notice you may request in writing to your local board:

Personal Apparance Before the Local Board — may be requested following your classification by the local board except when you are given an initial administrative 1-H classification, following your registration with the Selective Service System, or when the classification shown on this notice has been determined based upon information presented at a personal applicance requested by yourself.

Appeal to the Appeal Board — may be requested if the classification shown on this notice was made by the local board (except, when you are given an initial administrative 1-H classification, following your registration with the Selective Service System).

If you no longer live or work in the area under the jurisdiction of your lical board, you may file with your local board a written request that your appeal and personal appearance before an appeal board be heard by the appeal board having jurisdiction over the area in which your principal place of employment or current place of residence is located.

Personal Appearance Before the Appeal Board — may be requested if you are eligible to request an appeal to the appeal board. You may appeal to the appeal board without requesting a personal appearance before the appeal board, but if you wish to appear before the appeal board you must specifically ask for the appearance in addition to requesting an appeal.

If the classification contained on this notice was made by an appeal bland and there was at least one dissenting vote, you may request an appeal to the President and a personal appearance before the National Appeal Bland by filling a written request with your local board.
